



USA Shooting Board of Directors Special Emergency Board Action without a Meeting Minutes Sunday, Sept 20, 2026

On Sunday, September 20, 2026, the USA Shooting Board voted via email, as allowed by the USA Shooting Bylaws section "Action Without a Meeting," to adopt the Written Consent below:

WRITTEN CONSENT IN LIEU OF MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS USA SHOOTING, INC.

WHEREAS the ISSF World Championships are being held in Doha, Qatar in November 1-15, 2026; and

WHEREAS the Board of Directors has taken notice that the country of Qatar is on a Level 3 Alert issued by the United States Department of State; and

WHEREAS the Board has weighed the risks and benefits to USA Shooting and its athletes and other personnel of sending a delegation to compete at the World Championships; and

WHEREAS the Board of Directors has considered its obligations under the Ted Stevens Olympic and Amateur Sports Act not to deny an athlete the opportunity to compete in certain competitions, including the World Championships; and

WHEREAS the ISSF requires that all entries into the World Championships be submitted by Member Federations;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that:

1. USA Shooting shall not organize, fund, manage, or oversee a delegation of athletes, coaches, or support personnel to the World Championships; and
2. USA Shooting shall enter names of athletes and delegation members who (i) are otherwise qualified to be entered, (ii) request registration, and (iii) sign acceptances of reasonable conditions of entry, including but not limited to: a. assumption of all risks – known and unknown – of traveling to Qatar and participating in the World Championships; and b. waivers of claims against USA Shooting; and c. acknowledgment that USA Shooting is not providing any support for any person's participation; and d. acknowledgment and acceptance that cancellation after entry may cause financial costs for which the delegation member will be liable; and
3. USA Shooting shall not reward or punish any individual based on that individual's decision as to whether to participate or not; and



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4. The staff of USA Shooting shall undertake such measures as are necessary to apprise the USA Shooting community of the adoption of this Resolution and to implement this Resolution; and
5. This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption in accordance with Section 6.19 the Bylaws of USA Shooting and Colo. Rev. Stat. § 7-128-202.
